## PREACHING POINT APPLICATION

A preaching point is a regular service or meeting:

- Distinct from the mother church as to location or language and designed to reach people who are currently un-churched
- The definition of a preaching point does not include a church having a service in a prison, nursing home, jail, on a college campus or in any other institutional setting
- With the approval of a District NAM Executive Committee, an existing church can establish a
  preaching point in any city or town
- In the event there is a UPCI church in the town or city where the preaching point is being considered, and there is an objection or concern by the churches within the city, it is to be referred to the District Board
- · If approved, it is required that you begin this work within a year
